Aintree Championships Rules & Information

Sweet Meadow Unaffiliated Showjumping Championships

Location: Aintree International Equestrian Centre, L9 5S

Date: Saturday 27th – Sunday 28th September 2025

Class 1 Rules:

One round not against the clock. All clear rounds are placed equal first.

Lead rein is permitted to under 8s. Directional assistance re. the course is permitted INSIDE the arena for those who have recently come off the lead rein. Helping to prevent possible runouts or refusals is not permitted.

This class is only eligible for beginners. Any competitors competing in 50cm classes or above will not be eligible to compete in this class at the Unaffiliated Showjumping Championships.

Other Information:

- A Junior rider is aged 16 years and under and must be riding a pony under 14.2hh. Any riders aged 16 years and under and riding a horse must enter in the Senior Section.
- The **top 6 competitors** from each class will qualify for the Unaffiliated Showjumping Championships, subject to eligibility.



Sunshine Tour Qualification and Information

Championship Location: The All England Showground, Hickstead

Championship Date: Thursday 11th – Sunday 14th September 2025

Junior qualifying classes: Cross Poles - 90cm

Senior qualifying classes: 60cm – 1.00m

1ST - 3RD PLACE can be used to gain a qualification code.

Qualification DOES NOT go down the line.

Qualification is only valid if:

1. Both horse and competitor are registered and eligible to compete at The Sunshine Tour Championships. Restrictions apply. It is the COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY to ensure that both are eligible.
2. The competitor is correctly placed in a QUALIFIER CLASS within the qualification period.
3. Eligible placings are submitted via www.sunshinetour.co.uk within one month of competition, using screenshots/photos or downloads that CLEARLY SHOW the date, venue, class type, placing and competitor details.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- When eligible placings are submitted, they will be verified and issued with a unique QUALIFICATION CODE. Each qualification code can be used ONCE to enter one championship class.
- PAID FOR ENTRY is necessary to take part in the championship show, entries open 10th August 2025. Qualification does NOT guarantee entry in championship classes, classes fill quickly.
- Class Criteria: rules used to judge qualifying classes might not exactly match the championship class. It is the COMPETITOR'S RESPONSIBILITY to read the schedule about the rules and criteria of each class.
